## **Spring Sessions**

- What does it mean for our co-ops to be essential?
- What are the forces, internal and external, that are swirling around, pummeling your co-op?
  - What is happening inside your co-op, or internally, that is exerting force on it?
  - What is happening externally, or outside your co-op that is exerting force on it?
